

Tata Power making a mark

Many industries located in the Electronics City have made impressive accomplishments. Tata Power SED is one such company. It has supplied a state-of-the-art mobile telemetry system to ADA for testing "Tejas", the Light Combat Aircraft.

The system ascertains the capabilities of Tejas to achieve the stated goals of its mission under extreme conditions of temperature, altitude and humidity, typical of the weather conditions prevailing in the border areas. The system was jointly developed by ADA and Tata Power SED and was totally manufactured by Tata Power SED at its manufacturing facility located in Electronics City Bangalore.

The company has been involved in development and supply of state-of-the-art strategic electronic systems to the Indian Armed Forces for more than four decades.

It has made major contributions to prestigious import substitution and self reliance programs of the defence such as



the Integrated Guided Missile Development Program (IGMDP), Samyukta Electronic Warfare system of the Indian Army, Futuristic Automatic Data Handling System of the Indian Air Force. During his visit to ADA, the Defence Minister Mr A K Antony evinced keen interest in the mobile telemetry system supplied by Tata Power SED.

Mr Antony was accompanied by Scientific Advisor Mr Nataraajan. The mobile telemetry system was demonstrated to the Defence Minister by Wg. Cdr. Ravindran (retired), Group Director (Flight Testing) in the presence of Mr P S Subramanian, Program Director of ADA, Air Cmde Varma Project Director (Flight Testing) and Mr S. Gnyana Sundar, General Manager, Tata Power Company Limited.
